

Application Checklist



Master of Laws (LL.M.) Business Law in a Global Context

The required application materials are:

- Application form. (Completed and signed.)
- CAN \$100 fee, nonrefundable. (Payment must be issued by an international money order, made payable to "Université de Montréal Faculty of Law".)
- Personal Statement. (2-3 pages, double-spaced.)
- Two letters of recommendation. (Certified English or French translation if a letter is not written in English or in French.)
- Full transcript of grades. (One official set of academic records issued in the original language and a certified English or French translation.)
- Official score report of the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or of the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) unless the student has completed an undergraduate degree at a recognized institution where English is the language of instruction. (Preferred for evaluation, but not required to complete file. A candidate can be admitted subject to submitting the official score report at a later date.)

The application postmark deadline is April 30th, 2008, but the Admissions Committee will review applications as soon as they arrive. Early application submission is preferable. It allows time for an exchange of correspondence should the Admissions Committee require clarification or additional information.
